Telecom Regulatory Authority of India

TRAI releases report on Drive tests conducted in twelve cities and surrounding areas viz. Nellore, Salem, Visakhapatnam, Tumkur, Sangli, Rajkot, Udaipur, Kanpur, Indore, Dehradun, Meghalaya & Gopalganj and two highways Indore-Bhopal & Dehradun-Meerut.

New Delhi, 20th July 2022: TRAI, with the assistance of the Telecom Service Providers, conducted Drive Tests in twelve cities and surrounding areas viz. Nellore, Salem, Visakhapatnam, Tumkur, Sangli, Rajkot, Udaipur, Kanpur, Indore, Dehradun, Meghalaya & Gopalganj and two highways Indore- Bhopal & Dehradun-Meerut, conducted in the quarter ending March 2022.

The Drive tests were conducted to assess the network quality provided by cellular mobile telephone service providers for voice and data services. The details of drive tests conducted are given below;

2. The Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) were assessed for the networks of all telecom service providers operating in the region. KPIs for voice services are Coverage; Call Setup Success

Rate (CSSR); Drop Call Rate; Block Call Rate, Handover Success Rate; Rx Quality. KPIs for data services are Download and Upload Throughputs, Web Browsing Delay, Video Streaming Delay and Latency.
