TRAI releases Consultation Paper on 'In Flight Connectivity'

New Delhi, 29th September, 2017– The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) has today released a Consultation Paper on 'In Flight Connectivity'.

- 2. Department of Telecommunications through its reference dated 10th August 2017 has communicated that there is a proposal to introduce In-Flight Connectivity (IFC) for voice, data and video services over Indian airspace for domestic, international and overflying flights in Indian Air Space. DoT has also requested TRAI to furnish its recommendations on licensing terms and conditions for provision of IFC for voice, data and video services and associated issues such as entry fee, license fee, spectrum related issues including usage charges and method of allocation and other conditions.
