TRAI Releases Clarifications / Reconsideration of Recommendations on 'Valuation and Reserve Price of Spectrum in the 700 MHz, 800 MHz, 900 MHz, 1800 MHz, 2100 MHz, 2300 MHz and 2500 MHz bands'

New Delhi, 12th July 2016 - The Authority had sent its recommendations on "**Valuation and Reserve Price of Spectrum in the 700 MHz, 800 MHz, 900 MHz, 1800 MHz, 2100 MHz, 2300 MHz and 2500 MHz bands**" dated **27th January 2016** to the Department of Telecommunications (DoT). On 1st April 2016, the DoT sought clarifications/ reconsideration on some of the recommendations. After considering the comments given by the DoT, the Authority furnished its response to the DoT on 18th April 2016.

In the light of developments taken place since 18th April 2016 and other related facts, DoT vide letter dated 24th June 2016 sought reconsidered opinion of the Authority on the Spectrum Usage Charges.

On 12th July 2016, the Authority has given response to the DoT on Spectrum Usage Charges.
